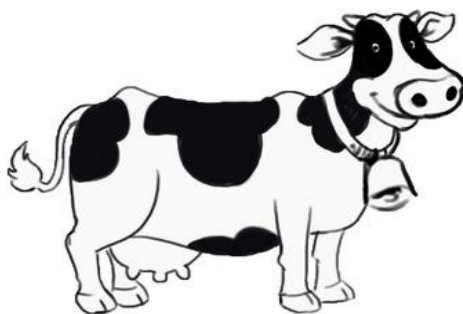

SHOW AND FIELD DAYS

Compliance with National Livestock Identification System (NLIS)

All Cattle moved to a show or field day must be identified with an NLIS device before leaving their property.

The owner or person in charge of the cattle is responsible for recording the movement of their cattle to the showground and back to their property of origin.

This information is to be on the NVD (National Vendor Declaration) and the Johne's Health Declaration form.

PLEASE NOTE:

All cattle must be identified with a NILS device

A Transported Stock Statement (TSS) must accompany the cattle both on the forward and return journey.

A TSS can be either a combined NVD/TSS or TSS (available from Kempsey Rural Lands Board Office).

Each exhibitor's cattle will be scanned with a portable scanner (it will be necessary for the exhibitor or his/her nominated representative to be on hand at the time of scanning to validate ownership and that the number of cattle scanned is correct.

The tail tag number (PIC) of the property of origin must be made available at the time of scanning.

The Show Society will notify the database of the movement.

REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS. – KEMPSEY SHOW 2026 DAIRY

1. All Entries will be pre-entry **ONLINE** only at www.globalentriesonline.com. Entries open on 16th March 2026 and close on 10th April 2026.
2. The Committee reserves the right of refusing to admit any exhibit on the grounds which there is reason to suspect is diseased, or otherwise unsuitable and also removing any such animal from the exhibition.
3. **AGE OF CATTLE:** Dairy as at 1st January this year.
4. ALL DAIRY exhibits must be in position for judging at 9am on the first day of show.
5. **CATTLE MUST BE PARADED WHEN REQUIRED.**
6. Interbreed Supreme Classes are open only to **CHAMPION** in each Breed.
7. All cattle must be true to type and meet breed standards, but do not need to be registered of their respective breed society. **Certificate of registration not required.** All cattle must be entered on the proper entry form available from Secretary's Office. Any exhibitor knowingly making false entries shall **FORFEIT ALL PRIZES.**
8. **DRY COW** means a cow at least 6 months in calf or 270 days in milk. **HEIFFER** means a female which has not had a calf. All cows entered as dry if in milk at the time of the competition may compete as wet cows and vice versa. **Dehorned cattle will not be penalised.**
9. Entries in Group or Progeny Classes are to be drawn from entries in general classes.
10. No prize-winning cattle are to leave the showground until after the Grand Parade without the approval of the Chief Steward. All prize-winning exhibits are to be paraded in the Grand Parade otherwise prizes will be forfeited
11. Exhibitors and Stewards shall withdraw to be a distance from the exhibits where practicable while they are being judged.
12. **ALL DAIRY CATTLE** must be properly restrained.
13. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, alter or vary any event in the Schedule or refuse any entry.
14. Dairy Exhibits **PLEASE NOTE.** This is a one-day Dairy Show held on the 1st day of the Show and a special parade will take place in the ring at a time to be announced.
15. Animal health form must be filled in.
16. Because of new **EBL** regulations **ALL DAIRY CATTLE MUST BE OFF THE GROUNDS BY 3.30PM** to permit Beef Cattle on grounds after 5 pm. Entries close Sunday 4pm 10th April 2026.
17. **ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT AND POWER LEADS.** Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of yourself, your fellow exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Occupational Health and Safety Act of 198. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any equipment or Leads not tagged will be inspected and tagged at the exhibitor's expense during the Show.
18. **ALL** exhibits must be entered in their own age group
19. All exhibitors are to Pay gate entry and bands are to be worn in Judging ring
20. Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle & Horses must be owned by exhibitor for a minimum of 30 days. Certificate of Registration to be shown on request.
